Untreated benign cardiac tumors may be life threatening. Treatment of myxoma is usually done by surgical removal of the tumor. Surgery to remove multiple nodules when Rhabdomyomas and fibromas are present is usually not effective.

General Information. Osteochondroma is an outgrowth of medullary and cortical bone; A portion of the cartilaginous growth plate grows outward instead of longitudinally and forms the osteochondroma/exostosis (like a branch on a tree)
