What companies run services between Granada, Spain and Seville, Spain? Spanish Railways (RENFE) operates a train from Granada to Seville every 4 hours. Tickets cost 27€ - 40€ and the journey takes 3h 15m. Alternatively, ALSA operates a bus from Granada to Seville every 4 hours. Tickets cost 22€ - 35€ and the journey takes 4h 30m.
